### #Trentinoskisunrise

**Alpe Lusia - Moena, Wednesday, 21<sup>st</sup> of February 2024 - 6.30 a.m.**

**Ronchi-Le Cune gondola, Fiamme Oro II slope, Moena Dolomiti Ski School, Chalet Valbona**

The first rays of sunlight illuminating the Dolomites, the authentic flavours of a 100% Val di Fassa breakfast, the sound of the bindings hooking up, the emotion of the blades cutting through a freshly groomed slope: you'll get to experience all this and leave your mark on the Fiamme Oro II!

### Programme

6.30 a.m. - Meeting point at the valley station of Ronchi-Le Cune gondola, in the locality of Ronchi, a few kilometres away from Moena. Set your alarm and be there on time, the gondola is making a special ride, just for us!

6.40 a.m. - All on board, let's go! Sitting comfortably, embraced by the crisp air and the stillness of the night that's about to give way to a new day. The more you ascend, the more fascinating it gets, because we're about to reach an extraordinary panoramic balcony!

6.50 a.m. - Here we are! Alpe Lusia always gives great emotions, whether it's winter or summer... Let's breathe in the fresh morning air and take some time to look around: Pale di San Martino, chain of Bocche and Lagorai, and the peaks of Catinaccio in the distance. The ski instructors of Moena's school will show us the summits, explaining their peculiarities and some fun facts. Then we refresh ourselves with a hot drink at Le Cune hut.

7.20 a.m. - It's time to put on your skis! Let's hook up the boots and off we go: the Fiamme Oro II is all for us! The ski instructors will accompany us and give us valuable advice. Skiers will slalom on the velvet slope, leaving their waggle signature. A unique experience!

7.30 a.m. - It's time for breakfast! Together with the managers of Chalet Valbona, we'll discover the natural products of Val di Fassa and Trentino. A rich breakfast that will make us taste the best local cheeses and cold cuts, as well as honey and jams, yoghurt and homemade cakes, fresh milk, eggs, and apples.

8.30 a.m. - Full of energies, the most experienced can also venture down the black slope Fiamme Oro I or try the other beautiful slopes of ski area Alpe Lusia. Those who reached the resort to enjoy a special sunrise, instead, can return to the village by gondola.

### Prices

Adults **€45** and children **€30** (6-12 years old; free under 6), including the **ascent** from the **valley** and the **employment** of **more lifts** specifically open for the occasion (pedestrians will make the return trip with the lifts), support by the **ski instructors** of the **local ski school** for the descent on the freshly groomed **slope** and tasty **breakfast at the hut**.

**The initiative will take place with a minimum of 20 participants.**

**The event is open to non-skiers too.**

In case of strong wind, or adverse weather conditions preventing the opening of the lifts or threatening the participants' safety, the initiative will be cancelled with full refund. The impossibility to fulfil the event will be communicated within 4.00 p.m. of the previous day.
